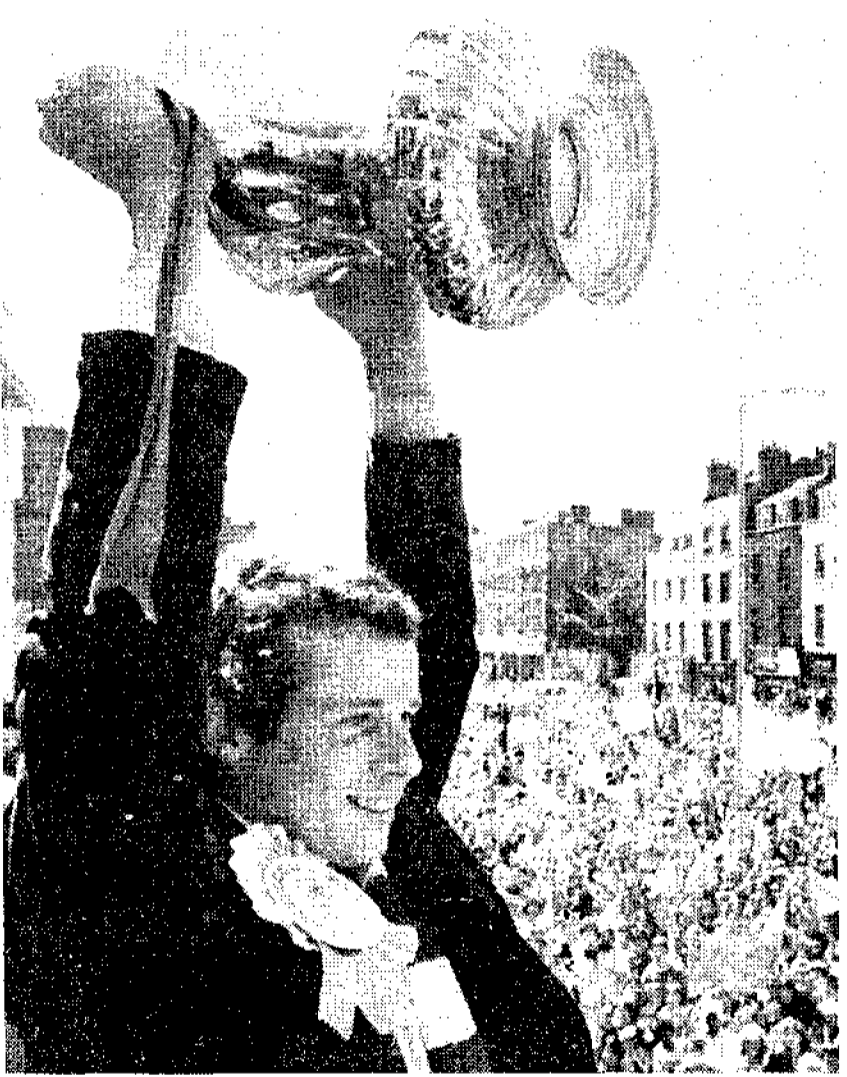

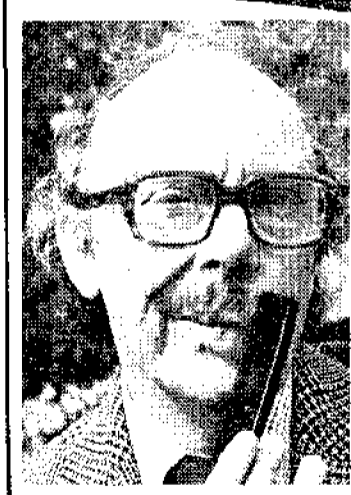


ARSENAL hero Liam Brady, with the Cup yesterday. Picture MONTE FRESCO
